Among other application requirements specific to international applicants and dependent upon their country of origin, a Canadian Study Permit may be required to study in Canada. Financial Aid, Scholarships & Bursaries

Helping our students fund their education is important to us. McKenzie College offers annual scholarships and bursaries to students who have been accepted into one of our programs. Additionally, international students may now also qualify for student loans if they meet certain requirements.
