

We teach essay and summary writing, how to give presentations, effective notetaking, skimming and scanning, and

more. We offer two different levels (EAP4 and 5) and successful completion of our EAP5 program is a recognized pathway stream for admission into many affiliated and partner colleges and universities in New Brunswick and beyond. Furthermore, if students need to improve their English for professional reasons, the EAP courses will provide the necessary skills to do so.

Pathway Programs and Articulation Agreements

English Skills Study Program (ESSP)

Our English Skills Study Programs cover all primary skills, thus listening, reading, writing and speaking, grammar and pronunciation. How you act is as important as what you say, we offer culture and customs training through situation-specific lessons, including how to act at job interviews. Completion of ESSP level 3 at 70% allows admission to our EAP4 course without additional testing.

Among other application requirements specific to international applicants and dependent upon their country of origin, a Canadian Study Permit may be required to study in Canada. Upon acceptance into one or more of McKenzie College's programs and upon payment of applicable fees, we will issue a Letter of Acceptance which should be included in your visa/study permit application. To facilitate the visa/ study permit application process, McKenzie has established partnerships with professional recruitment agents around the world who can help you with your application and immigration needs. Financial Aid, Scholarships & Bursaries

Helping our students fund their education is important to us. McKenzie College offers annual scholarships and bursaries to students who have been accepted into one of our programs. Students may apply for our scholarships each year they attend McKenzie College, even if they were awarded a scholarship or bursary in the previous year.

Many Canadian provinces offer student loan programs, grants, and bursaries that can provide financial assistance. Additionally, international students may now also qualify for student loans if they meet certain requirements. Students will have to complete their own applications, but McKenzie College will provide proof of enrolment if needed.
